Most convenient and concise source for recent publication.

Index to Legal Periodicals

Covers law review and related periodicals.

Public Affairs Information Service

Indexes publications with one sentence summaries. Includes U.S. Supreme Court entry.

Social Sciences Citation Index

Get a copy of the guide in the Reference Room. Wilson has on-line version for current year. Lists all articles cited during a given year. You can also trace all articles that have cited a work after its publication.

Annual Review of Sociology

Includes cumulative index. Occasional review articles on crime, deviance, law. Available on-line.
